<i>Clematis clitoroides</i>	pleasant clematis	climber with starry white flowers
<i>Hibbertia riparia</i>	erect guineaflower	golden flowers on short shrub
<i>Daviesia latifolia</i>	hop bitterpea	gold and brown peaflowers & veined leaves
<i>Acacia genistifolia</i>	spreading wattle	globular flower heads & rigid, pointed leaves
<i>Drosera auriculata</i>	sundew	tiny herb, pink flowers, leaves fringed with hairs
<i>Comesperma volubile</i>	blue lovecreeper	twiner with brilliant blue flowers
<i>Coronidium scorpioides</i>	curling everlasting	yellow daisy flowers and soft green leaves
<i>Acacia dealbata</i>	silver wattle	globular flower heads and feathery leaves

<i>Diuris pardina</i>	leopard orchid	large golden flowers spotted with brown
<i>Wurmbea dioica</i>	early nancy	small white flowers with maroon bars on petals
<i>Kennedia prostrata</i>	running postman	brilliant scarlet pea flowers on ground hugger

<i>Melicytus dentatus</i>	tree violet	spiky shrub with tiny yellow flowers on main stem
<i>Stackhousia monogyna</i>	forest candles	white flowers in spike

<i>Chiloglottis triceratops</i>	threehorn bird orchid	carpet of hundreds of plants; many in flower
