Aristotelia peduncularis	e	heartberry	straggling shrub to 1.5m; leaves to 70mm. lance-shaped, edges serrated; flowers white, bell-shaped, petals three-toothed; fruit heart shaped, white, red or black

Atherosperma moschatum		sassafras	tree to 25m; leaves to 8cm elliptical, margins often toothed; flowers white, in pairs, pendulous, 4-petalled. Male and female flowers on same or separate trees

Billardiera longiflora	e	purple appleberry	vine to 3m, clammers over other plants; leaves lance-like to 3cm; flowers tubular 2.5cm, yellow/green; fruit blue, sometimes white
Blechnum cartilagineum		soft water fern	Large fern in creeks in N and W, fronds tinged red, fertile fronds similar to leaves (distinguishing)
Blechnum wattsii		hard waterfern	fronds dark green, divided only once, fertile fronds different
Cassinia aculeata		dolly bush	shrub to 3 m; large clusters of small white flowers
Cenarrhenes nitida	e	native plum	shrub/small tree to 8m; leaves to 15cm, edges toothed; flowers small, white in spikes
Clematis aristata		mountain clematis	climber; leaves multi-lobed; large white star-like flowers
Coprosma quadrifida		native currant	erect shrub to 4m; leaves to 10mm; flowers, male & female on separate plants, 4 white petals; fruit shiny red/orange

Cyathodes glauca	e	purple cheeseberry	shrub to 3m; leaves pointed, to 5cm, green above whitish below; flowers tubular, white; fruit fleshy, white to red
Dianella tasmanica		forest flaxlily	perennial to 1.5m; leaves long, narrow, margins serrated; flowers on long stalks, 6-petalled, blue; fruit a blue/purple shiny berry
Dicksonia antarctica		soft treefern	Tall fern, trunks to several metres tall

Eucalyptus globulus		tasmanian bluegum	tree to 70m high, trunk rough at base, smooth, greyish/white above; leaves lance-shaped to 30cm long; fruit large, ribbed
Eucalyptus obliqua		stringybark	tree to 90m; trunk & branches covered in soft, ridged bark; leaves very unsymmetrical;
Exocarpos cupressiformis		common native-cherry	tree; conifer-like foliage; edible orange coloured fruit
Gahnia grandis		cutting grass	tufted perennial with narrow grass-like leaves with sharp, rough edges; flowers in spikes on culms to 3m
Gaultheria hispida		copperleaf snowberry	shrub to 1m; leaves dark green, edges serrated; flowers urn shaped, white/pink; fruit white, fleshy

Melaleuca squarrosa		scented paperbark	shrub/tree to 6m; leaves to 8mm, ovate, pointed; flowers yellow/cream in terminal bottle brushes
Microsorium pustulatum		kangaroo fern	Climbing fern on rocks or trees; fronds erect to pendant, widely separated; long creeping fleshy grey-green rooting stem
Monotoca elliptica		tree broomheath	Shrub to 5m; leaves slight-convex, oblong to 25mm, dark green above white below; flowers white tubular in clusters towards branch ends
Muehlenbeckia gunnii		forest lignum	woody twining climber to 10m high; leaves arrow-shaped, to 7cm long; flowers to 9mm diam, in groups of 2-6
Nothofagus cunninghamii		myrtle beech	tree to 50m; leaves roundish, new growth red; flowers inconspicuous
Notogrammitis heterophylla			epiphytic fern, fronds a crowded tuft. Rhizome short. Stem short and winged, scaly at base.
Olearia argophylla		musk daisybush	shrub/tree to 15 m; large leaves with silver back; flowers in large crowded heads.
Olearia persoonioides	e	geebung daisybush	shrub to 3m; leaves elliptical to 5cm, shiny above, hairy below; flower heads 3 to 5 on single stem
Olearia phlogopappa		dusty daisybush	shrub to 1.5m; leaves hairy under, margins somewhat toothed; white daisy flowers to 2 cm diam.

Pimelea cinerea	e grey riceflower	shrub to 2m high; leaves opposite, elliptical, to 3cm long, flat; flowers white, tubular, in few-flowered, terminal heads
Pimelea drupacea	cherry riceflower	shrub to 3m;
Pittosporum bicolor	cheesewood	tree to 8m, conical habit; leaves dark green above, lighter below; flowers bell-shaped, brown & yellow
Pomaderris apetala	common dogwood	shrub/tree to 10 m; leaves to 10 cm with deep veins, white under; flowers cream/green in branched clusters.
Prionotes cerinthoides	e climbing heath	climbing shrub to 10m high; leaves to 14mm long, oblong, margins serrated; flowers pink/red, tubular, to 25mm long
Prostanthera lasianthos	christmas bush	shrub/small tree to 5m high; leaves to 8cm long, lance-shaped, dark green above, lighter under; flowers white to pale lilac, purple spots in throat, in showy clusters
Richea dracophylla	e pineapple candleheath	shrub to 5 m; leaves long and tapering, the base sheathing the stem; flowers creamy white spikes to 25 cm, bracts fall as flowers mature.

blackwood
tree to 30m; leaves with parallel veins; round flower heads



GJ [*Acacia riceana*](#)

arching wattle
shrub/tree to 6 m; phyllodes clustered, to 3 cm long with sharp point; flowers yellow in spikes.



RW [*Anodopetalum biglandulosum*](#)

horizontal
shrub, or tree to 15m high; trunk usually bends over; leaves opposite, narrow elliptical, to 6cm long; flowers 4-petalled, cream/pale green



GJ [*Aristotelia peduncularis*](#)

heartberry

straggling shrub to 1.5m; leaves to 70mm. lance-shaped, edges serrated; flowers white, bell-shaped, petals three-toothed; fruit heart shaped, white, red or black



GJ [*Asplenium bulbiferum*](#)

mother spleenwort



GJ [*Atherosperma moschatum*](#)

sassafras

tree to 25m; leaves to 8cm elliptical, margins often toothed; flowers white, in pairs, pendulous, 4-petaled. Male and female flowers on same or separate trees



GJ [*Bedfordia salicina*](#)

tasmanian blanketleaf

shrub/tree to 5m; leaves dark green above silver hairy below; yellow daisy flowers in groups



GJ [*Billardiera longiflora*](#)

purple appleberry

vine to 3m, clammers over other plants; leaves lance-like to 3cm; flowers tubular 2.5cm, yellow/green; fruit blue, sometimes white



GJ [Blechnum cartilagineum](#)

soft water fern

Large fern in creeks in N and W, fronds tinged red, fertile fronds similar to leaves (distinguishing)



GJ [Blechnum wattsii](#)

hard waterfern

fronds dark green, divided only once, fertile fronds different



GJ [Cassinia aculeata](#)

dolly bush

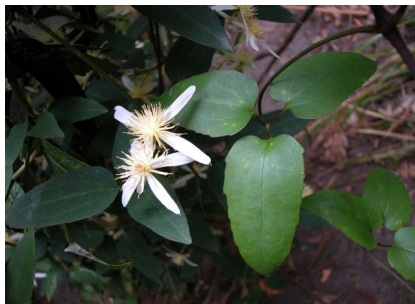
shrub to 3 m; large clusters of small white flowers



GJ [Cenarrhenes nitida](#)

native plum

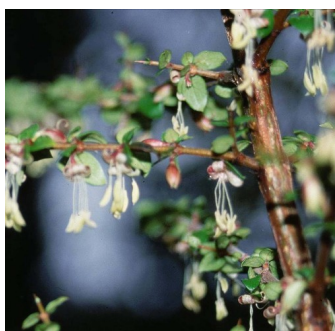
shrub/small tree to 8m; leaves to 15cm, edges toothed; flowers small, white in spikes



GJ [Clematis aristata](#)

mountain clematis

climber; leaves multi-lobed; large white star-like flowers



GJ *Coprosma quadrifida*

native currant
erect shrub to 4m; leaves to 10mm; flowers, male & female on separate plants, 4 white petals; fruit shiny red/orange

RS *Cyathodes glauca*

purple cheeseberry
shrub to 3m; leaves pointed, to 5cm, green above whitish below; flowers tubular, white; fruit fleshy, white to red



BC *Dianella tasmanica*

forest flaxlily
perennial to 1.5m; leaves long, narrow, margins serrated; flowers on long stalks, 6-petalled, blue; fruit a blue/purple shiny berry



GJ *Dicksonia antarctica*

soft treefern
Tall fern, trunks to several metres tall

gumtopped stringybark
tree to 50m; stringy bark on most of trunk, branches white;
leaves asymmetrical.



GJ [*Eucalyptus globulus*](#)

tree to 70m high, trunk rough at base, smooth, greyish/white
above; leaves lance-shaped to 30cm long; fruit large, ribbed



GJ [*Eucalyptus obliqua*](#)

stringybark
tree to 90m; trunk & branches covered in soft, ridged bark;
leaves very unsymmetrical;



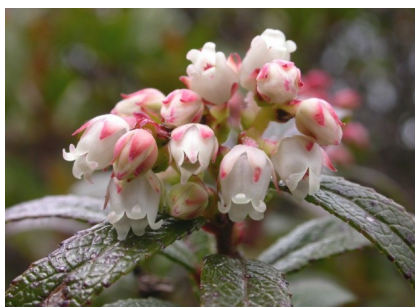
GJ [*Exocarpos cupressiformis*](#)

common native-cherry
tree; conifer-like foliage; edible orange coloured fruit



GJ *Gahnia grandis*

cutting grass
tufted perennial with narrow grass-like leaves with sharp, rough edges; flowers in spikes on culms to 3m



RS *Gaultheria hispida*

copperleaf snowberry
shrub to 1m; leaves dark green, edges serrated; flowers urn shaped, white/pink; fruit white, fleshy



GJ *Gleichenia dicarpa*

pouched coralfern



GJ *Goodenia ovata*

hop native-primrose
shrub to 2m; leaves bright green, to 6cm, edges toothed;
flowers yellow with petals in two groups

shrub to 4m high; leaves usually narrow lance-shaped, hairy under; flowers white, in terminal racemes; fruit woody,

GJ *Melaleuca pallida*

yellow bottlebrush, leathery lanceolate leaves



GJ *Melaleuca squarrosa*

scented paperbark
shrub/tree to 6m; leaves to 8mm, ovate, pointed; flowers
yellow/cream in terminal bottle brushes



GJ *Microsorium pustulatum*

kangaroo fern
Climbing fern on rocks or trees; fronds erect to pendant, widely
separated; long creeping fleshy grey-green rooting stem



GJ *Monotoca elliptica*

tree broomheath
Shrub to 5m; leaves slight-convex, oblong to 25mm, dark
green above white below; flowers white tubular in clusters
towards branch ends



Muehlenbeckia gunnii

forest lignum
woody twining climber to 10m high; leaves arrow-shaped, to
7cm long; flowers to 9mm diam, in groups of 2-6



RS *Nothofagus cunninghamii*

myrtle beech
tree to 50m; leaves roundish, new growth red; flowers
inconspicuous



AucM *Notoqrammitis heterophylla*

epiphytic fern, fronds a crowded tuft. Rhizome short. Stem short and winged, scaly at base.



GJ *Olearia argophylla*

musk daisybush
shrub/tree to 15 m; large leaves with silver back; flowers in large crowded heads.



RS *Olearia persoonioides*

geebung daisybush
shrub to 3m; leaves elliptical to 5cm, shiny above, hairy below; flower heads 3 to 5 on single stem



GJ *Olearia phlogopappa*

dusty daisybush
shrub to 1.5m; leaves hairy under, margins somewhat toothed; white daisy flowers to 2 cm diam.

shrub to 1.5m; leaves hairy under, margins somewhat toothed; white daisy flowers to 2 cm diam.

variable orites
shrub to 2m; leaves variable, to 7cm long; flowers in pairs,

conifer tree to 20m; "leaves" diamond shaped, thick, often
lobed; female flowers fleshy in groups attached to "leaves",
white & red



GJ *Pimelea cinerea*

grey riceflower
shrub to 2m high; leaves opposite, elliptical, to 3cm long, flat;
flowers white, tubular, in few-flowered, terminal heads



BC *Pimelea drupacea*

cherry riceflower
shrub to 3m;



AS *Pittosporum bicolor*

cheesewood

tree to 8m, conical habit; leaves dark green above, lighter below; flowers bell-shaped, brown & yellow



GJ *Pomaderris apetala*

common dogwood

shrub/tree to 10 m; leaves to 10 cm with deep veins, white under; flowers cream/green in branched clusters.



GJ *Prionotes cerinthoides*

climbing heath

climbing shrub to 10m high; leaves to 14mm long, oblong, margins serrated; flowers pink/red, tubular, to 25mm long



GJ *Prostanthera lasianthos*

christmas bush

shrub/small tree to 5m high; leaves to 8cm long, lance-shaped, dark green above, lighter under; flowers white to pale lilac, purple spots in throat, in showy clusters



BC *Richea dracophylla*

pineapple candleheath

shrub to 5 m; leaves long and tapering, the base sheathing the stem; flowers creamy white spikes to 25 cm, bracts fall as flowers mature.



GJ *Rumohra adiantiformis*

leathery shieldfern



GJ *Sticherus tener*

silky fanfern



RS *Tasmania lanceolata*

mountain pepper

tree to 5m; leaves lance-shaped on red stems; flowers yellow;
fruit red turning black



GJ *Tmesipteris obliqua*

common forkfern



GJ *Westringia angustifolia*

narrowleaf westringia

shrub with narrow revolute leaves. Distinguished by (white)
flowers having acuminate sepals
