GJ Acacia genistifolia

spreading wattle shrub; golden flowers in spheres; stiff dagger-like leaves



AS Acacia longifolia

subsp. sophorae coastal wattle dense branched shrub or tree to 5m, bark dark grey, dark on trunk, smooth branches, dense red rod flowers single or in pairs in leaf axils



RW Acacia mearnsii

black wattle tree with green feathery leaves; pale golden flowers



GJ Acacia melanoxylon

blackwood tree to 30m; leaves with parallel veins; round flower heads



RW Acacia mucronata

caterpillar wattle shrub/tree to 10m; leaves leathery, narrow, to15cm; flowers cream/yellow in spikes



GJ Acacia myrtifolia

redstem wattle shrub to 2m; stems red; leaves to 5cm, leathery, single vein; flowers cream in spherical heads



GJ Acacia suaveolens

sweet wattle shrub to 2 m; phyllodes blue/green to 15 cm; flowers round, cream, in axils, sweet scented.



GJ Acacia terminalis

sunshine wattle shrub to 4m high; leaves feathery; flowers in bunches of spherical heads

Acacia verticillata

subsp. ovoidea prickly moses shrub 50cm to 6m high; leaves in whorls, narrow pungent pointed, to 2cm long; flowers in cylindrical pale yellow oval spikes



GJ Acacia verticillata

subsp. verticillata prickly moses shrub 50cm to 6m high; leaves in whorls, narrow pungent pointed, to 12mm long; flowers in cylindrical yellow spikes



RS <u>Acaena novae-zelandiae</u>

common buzzy herb; leaves divided; balls of flower/seeds with hooks



GJ Acrotriche serrulata

ants delight dark green low shrub; prickly leaves; flowers underneath



GJ Actites megalocarpus

dune thistle

perennial herb to 60cm; leaves in basal rosette; leaves to 15cm, lobed, prickly;yellow daisy flowers



RS? <u>Allocasuarina littoralis</u>

black sheoak tree; fruit like small pine cones; segmented needle-like "leaves"



GJ Allocasuarina monilifera

necklace sheoak shrub to 4m; leaves like tiny teeth aroung joints in neele-like branchlets; fruit, cylindrical cones with pointed ends



GJ Allocasuarina verticillata

drooping sheoak tree with "leaves" hanging down or drooping



GJ <u>Almaleea subumbellata</u>

wiry bushpea shrub to 90 cm; leaves oblong to 8 mm; yellow/orange pea flowers in bunches at ends of stems





GJ Aotus ericoides

golden pea shrub to 1.5m; leaves narrow to 12mm long, margins downrolled; yellow pea flower with red throat

GJ Argentipallium dealbatum

white everlasting herb to 25cm; leaves elliptic, dark green above, white hairy under; flower buds red, fllowers single, white, papery



GJ <u>Atriplex cinerea</u>

grey saltbush shrub to 1.5m high; leaves white/grey, scaly, oblong to 6cm long; flowers unisexual, in dense clusters



GJ <u>Banksia marginata</u>

silver banksia tree with typical banksia cones or yellow flower spikes



GJ <u>Bauera rubioides</u>

wiry bauera sprawling wiry shrub; leaves opposite, each with three leaflets; flowers white to pink





GJ Bedfordia salicina

tasmanian blanketleaf shrub/tree to 5m; leaves dark green above silver hairy below; yellow daisy flowers in groups

GJ <u>Boronia anemonifolia</u>

stinky boronia shrub to 2m high; leaves dark green, with 3 leaflets, to 1.5cm long; flowers 4-petalled, white/pink



GJ Boronia parviflora

swamp boronia prostrate or dwarf shrub; leaves to 2 cm; flowers small with 4 pointed petals.



GJ Bossiaea cinerea

showy bossia shrub with gold/brown pea flowers



GJ Brachyloma ciliatum

fringed heath

shrub, wiry to 30cm high; leaves oblong to ovate, pungent pointed, to 10mm long; flowers solitary, white, tubular with hairs at throat



GJ Bulbine bulbosa

golden bulbine-lily herb; soft hollow leaves tufted at base; spike of 6-petalled yellow flowers, has a tuber

GJ Burchardia umbellata

milkmaids herb; leaves grass-like; white 6-petalled flowers with maroon centres




GJ Cakile edentula

american searocket annual herb to 60 cm growing on beaches;leaves 3-6 cm long; flowers with 4 white/pink/mauve petals.



JC <u>Caladenia carnea</u>

pink fingers herb to 25 cm; single narrow narrow; 1 to 6 showy pink flowers



GJ Callitris oblonga

subsp. oblonga south esk pine Narrow tree to 5m, blue-green leaves to 1mm in whorls of 3, pear shaped female cones 1cm, with 3 large and 3 small scales





GJ Callitris rhomboidea

oyster bay pine Narrow tree to 6m, green leaves to 2-5mm in whorls of 3, pear shaped female cones 2cm, with 6 pointed scales of sililar size

BC Calytrix tetragona

common fringemyrtle shrub; star-like white flowers



GJ <u>Carpobrotus rossii</u>

native pigface herb, prostrate, spreading; leaves fleshy, triangular x-section; flowers large, pink/purple, white centres



GJ Cassytha melantha

large dodderlaurel "monkey twine", parasitic on other plants



GJ Cassytha pubescens

downy dodderlaurel parasitic twiner; appears leafless; flowers small, white, crowded in groups/spikes



GJ Centella cordifolia

swampwort

prostrate marsh herb; leaves almost circular; flowers small, pink in clusters on short stalks

GJ <u>Chrysocephalum apiculatum</u>

common everlasting perennial herb to 50cm; stem & leaves densely hairy; golden daisy flowers in clusters



GJ Clematis microphylla

small-leaf clematis climber to 3m high; leaves twice divided, leaflets to 3cm long; flowers 4 "petalled", cream



GJ Comesperma volubile

blue lovecreeper wiry climber; small leaves; blue flowers along stems



GJ <u>Conospermum hookeri</u>

tasmanian smokebush ozothamnus-like bush, distinctive white flowers



GJ Coprosma quadrifida

native currant

erect shrub to 4m; leaves to 10mm; flowers, male & female on separate plants, 4 white petals; fruit shiny red/orange



RS Coronidium scorpioides

curling everlasting herb with single golden daisy flower heads on long stems



AS <u>Correa alba</u>

var. alba white correa coastal shrub/tree to 3 m; leaves green/grey, oval to round, hairy, to 4 cm; flowers white, starry, with curved petals and prominent stamens.





GJ Correa backhouseana

var. backhouseana velvet correa Dense shrub to 2m, oval tough stalked leaves, 2.5cm tube flowers cream to pale green with 4 flared pointed petals. Found on W and S coast

GJ Correa reflexa

var. reflexa common correa shrub, variable from prostrate to 3 m; leaves to 5 cm, reflexed with indented veins; flowers tubular, pendant, greenish.





GJ Corybas incurvus

slaty helmet-orchid small orchid; leaf heart-shaped, green below; flower dark purple with white central patch and a fringe of short teeth

RW Daviesia ulicifolia

yellow spiky bitterpea prickly woody shrub to 2 m; leaves spiky to 3 cm; yellow pea flowers with reddish markings.



GJ Dichondra repens

kidneyweed creeping herb, forming patches; kidney shaped leaves; tiny green/white flowers



GJ <u>Dillwynia glaberrima</u>

smooth parrotpea slender shrub to 90cm; leaves hairless, narrow cylindrical; golden pea flowers



GJ Dillwynia sericea

showy parrotpea shrub to 60cm high; leaves cylindrical, to 2cm long, grooved on upper surface; pea flowers orange/yellow, very broad





GJ Diplarrena moraea

white flag-iris strap-like leaves; white flowers

GJ <u>Dipodium roseum</u>

rosy hyacinth-orchid leafless red/brown stem to 80 cm; numerous showy pink flowers



AS <u>Disphyma crassifolium</u>

subsp. clavellatum roundleaf pigface fleshy, perennial, prostrate herb; leaves circular in x-section; flowers pink/white, 3-4cm diam



JC Dockrillia striolata

rock orchid

lithophyte forms compact clumps leaves terete straight or curved shallowly grooved green or reddish flowers 1-3 upside down greenish to brownish yellow or bright yellow racemes to 20mm



gj <u>Dodonaea viscosa</u>

subsp. spatulata native hop shrub/small tree to 6m high; leaves glossy,oblong, to 6cm long; flowers small, yellow; fruit 3-winged, green to reddish







GJ <u>Drosera binata</u>

forked sundew

herb; leaves forked, on long stem, blades with glistening hairs; flowers white, to 2cm diam, in groups of up to 40

GJ Drosera gunniana

pale sundew erect herb to 30cm high; leaves at base round on stem crescent shaped, fringed with glistening hairs; flowers white or pink

DW Drosera macrantha

subsp. planchonii climbing sundew herb; fine stem with round leaves fringed with glistening hairs

GJ Drosera pygmaea

dwarf sundew tiny carnivorous herb; leaves round, fringed with hairs, in basal rosette; tiny single white flower



GJ Drosera spatulata

ray sundew

herb; leaves in a rosette, red, appressed to ground; flowers white in 1 or 2 groups of several flowers







GJ Epacris impressa

common heath shrub; white, red or pink tubular flowers with dimples at base

GJ Epacris lanuginosa

swamp heath erect narrow shrub to 1.5m; leaves narrow lance-shaped with sharp point; flowers white, tubular in clusters

GJ Epacris obtusifolia

bluntleaf heath shrub to 1m high; leaves to 10mm long, elliptical, blunt, appressed to stem; flowers white/cream, tubular

GJ Epacris tasmanica

eastern heath erect woody bush to 2m, shiny rounded and pointed leaves, single white 5-petalled tubular flowers in the axils towards top of stems



GJ Eucalyptus amygdalina

black peppermint tree 15 to 30 m with fine rough bark; leaves narrow; buds 7-15+





GJ Eucalyptus globulus

tasmanian bluegum tree to 70m high, trunk rough at base, smooth, greyish/white above; leaves lance-shaped to 30cm long; fruit large, ribbed

GJ Eucalyptus obliqua

stringybark tree to 90m; trunk & branches covered in soft, ridged bark; leaves very unsymmetrical;



GJ Eucalyptus ovata

var. ovata black gum large gum tree; rough grey bark; oval leaves



GJ Eucalyptus pulchella

white peppermint Small tree to 20m, smooth white-grey bark, very narrow leaves 5-10cm, 5mm buds in clusters up to 18, nuts with valves level with rim



RW <u>Eucalyptus tenuiramis</u>

silver peppermint tree to 25 m with smooth bark; leaves blue/green; buds 7-15+



GJ Euryomyrtus ramosissima

rosy heathmyrtle shrub to 50cm; leaves linear to 10mm; flowers ca 10mm diam, 5 white/pink petals

GJ Exocarpos cupressiformis

common native-cherry tree; conifer-like foliage; edible orange coloured fruit



GJ <u>Glossodia major</u>

waxlip orchid herb to 30 cm; single hairy leaf; 1 or 2 large purple/ mauve flowers



GJ Glycine clandestina

twining glycine climber with trifoliate leaves & purple flowers



BC Gompholobium huegelii

common wedgepea herb; pea flower yellow inside and blackish outside



GW <u>Gonocarpus teucrioides</u>

forest raspwort

perennial herb to 60 cm; leaves oval and rough to touch; flowers on leafy spikes with petals often fallen.



RS Goodenia lanata

trailing native-primrose prostrate herb; leaves to 7cm, dark green above lighter below; flowers golden, asymmetric on long stem

GJ Goodenia ovata

hop native-primrose shrub to 2m; leaves bright green, to 6cm, edges toothed; flowers yellow with petals in two groups



GJ Goodia lotifolia

smooth goldentip shrub to 4m high; leaves with 3 leaflets;



GJ Hakea epiglottis

subsp. epiglottis beaked needlebush shrub to 3 m; leaves cylindrical with upward curve and sharp point; flowers cream/yellow; fruit 'S' shaped.



GJ Hakea lissosperma

mountain needlebush small tree to 6m; leaves cylindrical sharply pointed; flowers white; fruit almost round with short beak and warty surface

GJ Hakea microcarpa

smallfruit needlebush sharp needle-like leaves, white flowers, small woody fruits



GJ Hakea teretifolia

subsp. hirsula dagger hakea Woody shrub to 4m, rigid, cylindrical leaves sharply pointed, scented white spider-flowers, dagger shaped fruit with sharp warts at base



GJ Hibbertia empetrifolia

scrambling guineaflower shrub, scrambling to 2m high; leaves elliptic, to 8mm long, hairy; flowers yellow, 6mm diam, petals with notched tips



GJ <u>Hibbertia prostrata</u>

prostrate guineaflower yellow symmetric five-petal flowers; narrow leaves



BC Hibbertia riparia

erect guineaflower shrub; narrow leaves; golden 5-petalled flowers



GJ Hovea heterophylla

winter purplepea small shrub; dark green leaves; violet pea flowers



RW Indigofera australis

native indigo shrub to 1.5m high; leaves feather-like, to 10 leaflets; pea flowers pink/mauve, crowded along branches



GJ Kennedia prostrata

running postman herb; prostrate & sprawling; leaves with 3 leaflets; crimson pea flower



GJ <u>Kunzea ambigua</u>

white kunzea shrub to 4m; masses of white flowers; leaves narrow, tufted



GJ Lasiopetalum macrophyllum

shrubby velvetbush

shrub to 2m high; leaves ovate to 10cm long, rusty hairs along veins, white/green under; flowers small, white, in pendant clusters

GJ Leptomeria drupacea

erect currantbush Much branched shrub to 2 m; leaves are tiny scales on stem; flowers very small, cream; fruit fleshy, reddish.

GJ Leptospermum glaucescens

smoky teatree upright shrub/tree to 8m; leaves grey-green to 2cm; flowers white with red centres; fruit small, reddish, leathery

GJ Leptospermum grandiflorum

autumn teatree large shrub to 5 m; leaves grey/green; flowers large white about 3 cm across.



RS Leptospermum lanigerum

woolly teatree shrub or small tree; leaves hairy; flowers white, hairy at base; fruit hairy at base







GJ Leptospermum scoparium

common teatree

shrub to 4m; leaves to 2cm with prickly pointed tips; flowers white; fruit with 5 slits, top convex, woody

BC Leucopogon collinus

white beardheath shrub to 50cm; leaves with edges turned down; flowers tiny, tubular, bearded inside, in clusters at ends of branches



GJ Leucopogon parviflorus

coast beardheath shrub to 3m; leaves to 3cm, blunt pointed, margins rolled down; flowers white, tubular, bearded inside



BC Leucopogon virgatus

common beard-heath shrub to 1 m; small white flowers; petals woolly above



GJ Lobelia anceps

angled lobelia perennial herb, prostrate, scrambling; stem with flattened ridges; flowers small, blue, two-lipped







GJ Lomandra longifolia

sagg

tussock of strap-like leaves with notched ends; flowers in spiny clusters

GJ Lomatia tinctoria

guitarplant shrub; divided leaves very variable in form; white flowers

GJ <u>Melaleuca gibbosa</u>

slender honeymyrtle shrub to 3m; leaves crowded, to 6mm; flowers mauve/pink bottle brushes to 3cm long

GJ <u>Melaleuca squamea</u>

swamp honeymyrtle shrub to 3m; leaves to 8mm, hairy; flowers mauve/white in termianl globular heads





GJ Melaleuca squarrosa

scented paperbark shrub/tree to 6m; leaves to 8mm, ovate, pointed; flowers yellow/cream in terminal bottle brushes



GJ Monotoca elliptica

tree broomheath

Shrub to 5m; leaves slight-convex, oblong to 25mm, dark green above white below; flowers white tubular in clusters towards branch ends



RW <u>Monotoca glauca</u>

goldey wood shrub to 3m; leaves to 10mm, sharp points; flowers white, 5 petalled, in small groups



GJ <u>Olearia ciliata</u>

fringed daisybush shrub to 40 cm; narrow leaves; solitary white to mauve flowers on long stem



GJ <u>Olearia lirata</u>

forest daisybush shrub to 5m; numerous white daisy flowers at ends of branches



GJ <u>Olearia ramulosa</u>

twiggy daisybush shrub to 2 m; leaves small with rolled edges; flowers white, numerous with 6-10 ray florets.



GJ Ornduffia reniformis

running marshflower fleshy herb in water or on wet mud; leaves kidney-shaped to 10cm across; flowers bright yellow, 2-4cm diam, in groups

GJ Ozothamnus obcordatus

yellow everlastingbush Shrub .5-1.5m, heart-shaper alternate leaves, glossy on top, hairy below, terminal tight clusters of yellow flowers massed in spring



GJ Ozothamnus reticulatus

veined everlastingbush open shrub to 3 m; leaves linear to 6 cm with depressed vein; small white daisy flowers in dense heads to 6 cm across.



GJ Patersonia fragilis

short purpleflag densely tufted herb; leaves narrow, flat, to 40cm long; flowers purple, 3-petaled, on stems shorter than the leaves



GJ Pelargonium australe

southern storksbill herb growing in rock crevices; leaves kidney-shaped; flowers pink/white



GJ Pentachondra involucrata

forest frillyheath

shrub to 40cm; leaves elliptical to 2cm; flowers white, petals hairy inside, clustered in small groups at ends of branches



GJ Persoonia juniperina

prickly geebung shrub; to 1.5 m tall; light green prickly leaves; delicate golden flowers



GJ Philotheca verrucosa

fairy waxflower shrub; branches warty; profusion of white star-like flowers



GJ Philotheca virgata

twiggy waxflower shrub to 2m; stems warty; leaves narrow oblong to 2cm; flowers white star-shaped, 4-5 petals



GJ Phyllanthus gunnii

shrubby spurge shrub to 3m; new stems red; leaves round; flowers small, white/green, 5 petals, in clusters





GJ <u>Pimelea flava</u>

yellow riceflower

Slender shrub ro 1m, elliptical opposite leaves with prominent mid-vein on short stem, yellow flowers in erect terminal clusters, lime bracts

GJ Pimelea glauca

smooth riceflower Branched shrup to 80cm, blue-green hairless opposite leaves on hairless stem, white tube flowers in terminal heads with 4 bracts wider than leaves. Does not sucker

GJ <u>Pimelea humilis</u>

dwarf riceflower dwarf shrub to 20cm tall; white flowers grouped in terminal heads



RW <u>Plantago triantha</u>

saltspray plantain rosette herb; leaves thick to 4 cm long with 1-2 pairs blunt teeth



GJ <u>Platylobium obtusangulum</u>

common flatpea shrub to 1 m tall; triangular leaves; yellow pear flowers



GJ Platylobium triangulare

arrow flatpea

scrambling shrub; leaves triangular with sharp tips; flowers orange/yellow pea with bracts that don't conceal the stem.



GJ <u>Pomaderris apetala</u> subsp. apetala

shrub/tree to 10 m; leaves to 10 cm with deep veins, white under; flowers cream/green in branched clusters.



GJ Pomaderris elliptica

yellow dogwood shrub/tree to 8 m; leaves to 10 cm, smooth, rusty under; flowers yellow, clustered.

Pomaderris elliptica var. diemenica dogwood Shrub/tree to 10m, ovate leaves - tops veins indented, below hairy and veins prominent, cream flowers in branching cymes, no petals



GJ <u>Pteridium esculentum</u>

subsp. esculentum bracken common fern to 2.5m tall; leathery much divided frond







GJ Pterostylis nutans

nodding greenhood orchid with single green nodding flowe on stem to 30cm

GJ Pultenaea daphnoides

heartleaf bushpea woody shrub to 2.5 m; leaves wedge-shaped with sharp point at end of central vein; golden pea flowers in terminal heads.

GJ Pultenaea dentata

swamp bushpea shrub to 90cm tall; leaves to 10mm long,crowded near ends of branches; yellow, pea flowers in small terminal bunches



GJ <u>Pultenaea gunnii</u> subsp. gunnii

shrub to 1.5m high, branches hairy; leaves to 2cm long; linear to elliptical; yellow pea flowers in terminal heads



RW Pultenaea juniperina

prickly beauty shrub to 2.5m; leaves to 12mm, sharp pointed; goledn pea flowers at ends of branches





GJ Pultenaea tenuifolia

slender bushpea prostrate shrub; leaves to 8mm long, narrow with upper channel; yellow/red pea flowers, solitary, near branch ends

GJ <u>Rhagodia candolleana</u> subsp. candolleana coastal saltbush scrambling shrub to 2 m; leaves fleshy, oval to arrow shaped; flowers terminal clusters followed by flat dark red fruits.



RW <u>Rhytidosporum procumbens</u>

starry appleberry dwarf shrub to 10 cm; leaves crowded, stalkless, dark green; flowers starry with 5 white petals



GJ Scaevola hookeri

creeping fanflower herb, spreading, prostrate; leaves variable, ovate, hairy; flowers white, hairy outside, petals winged



GJ Senecio hispidulus

rough fireweed herb to 1.25m; leaf with rough upper surface; small flower heads without "petals"





GJ Senecio linearifolius

common fireweed perennial herb to 2m; leaves narrow linear; yellow daisy flowers in clusters

GJ <u>Senecio minimus</u>

shrubby fireweed perennial herb to 1.2m high; leaves vble, toothed, lower ones broader, lanceolate, to 15cm long; flower heads without "petals", yellow, numerous



GJ <u>Solanum laciniatum</u>

kangaroo apple shrub; lobed leaves; large purple flowers; yellow/orange fruit



GJ Sphaerolobium minus

eastern globepea leafless wiry herb to 75 cm; yellow pea flowers crowded at upper end of stems.



GJ <u>Spinifex sericeus</u>

beach spinifex

perennial grass, with long, prostrate, creeping stems; male flowers in hemispherical heads; female flowers in large sherical, spiky heads





GJ Sprengelia incarnata

pink swampheath erect shrub to 2m; leaves hard, pointed, sheathing stem; flowers pink/white, in terminal clusters

GJ Stackhousia monogyna

forest candles herb to 50cm. several erect stems; leaves narrow; flowers white tubular in dense spikes at ends of stems.



GJ <u>Stenanthemum pimeleoides</u>

propeller plant shrub; prostrate; tiny flowers surrounded by three white bracts



BC Stylidium graminifolium

narrowleaf triggerplant herb to 50cm; leaves narrow, strap-like; flowers pink, fourpetalled, in spikes



GJ Styphelia adscendens

golden heath prostrate shrub to 50cm; leaves to 3cm, pointed, edges hairy; flowers tubular, yellow/green, hairy inside



GJ Styphelia ericoides

pink beardheath

erect woody shrub to 1m; leaves to 13mm, edges turned down; flowers numerous along branches, white, tubular, hairy inside



GJ Styphelia humifusa

native cranberry ground cover; prickly leaves; red tube flowers in winter



GJ <u>Tetragonia implexicoma</u>

bower spinach sprawling undershrub; leaves diamond shaped, succulent to 4 cm; flowers yellow with 4 petals, on long stems.



GJ <u>Tetratheca pilosa</u>

hairy pinkbells shrub to 60 cm tall; pink flowers pendulous on stalks



GJ <u>Trachymene composita</u> var. composita

herb to 1.2m high, stems grooved; leaves divided, hairy under; flowers numerous in flat-topped groups on hairy stalks



GJ Viola hederacea

ivyleaf violet

herb; perennial, spreading; kidney shaped leaves; violet flowers on stalks

GJ Xanthorrhoea australis

southern grasstree Stem to 3m, may be branched, tuft of long,3mm, angular sectioned leaves, yellow-brown flowers in spike standing up to 2.5, above leaves



GJ Xanthosia ternifolia

shrubby crossherb small shrub; leaves 3-lobed, hairy; flowers tiny, in groups



GJ Xanthosia tridentata

hill crossherb shrub to 30cm high; leaves6-15mm long, apex 3-notched; flowers in groups of 1-3



GJ Zieria littoralis

downy zieria

Grey shrub 30cm to 1m, trifoliate leaves, soft with deep central indent, white or pink flowers with 4 petals inclusters on stalks from leaf axils
