Adiantum aethiopicum		common maidenhair	delicate plant with fan-shaped leaves
Allocasuarina littoralis		black sheoak	tree; fruit like small pine cones; segmented needle-like "leaves"
Allocasuarina verticillata		drooping sheoak	tree with "leaves" hanging down or drooping
Asplenium flabellifolium		necklace fern	small fern with leaves pinnately divided into wedge-shaped leaflets, alternately arranged
Bedfordia salicina	e	tasmanian blanketleaf	shrub/tree to 5m; leaves dark green above silver hairy below; yellow daisy flowers in groups
Beyeria viscosa		pinkwood	small tree; inconspicuous flower; female plants have 3-lobed fruit

<i>Callitris rhomboidea</i>	oyster bay pine	Narrow tree to 6m, green leaves to 2-5mm in whorls of 3, pear shaped female cones 2cm, with 6 pointed scales of similar size
<i>Cassytha glabella</i>	slender dodderlaurel	slender parasitic twiner; appears leafless; tiny white flowers in bunches on short stalks
<i>Clematis aristata</i>	mountain clematis	climber; leaves multi-lobed; large white star-like flowers
<i>Coprosma quadrifida</i>	native currant	erect shrub to 4m; leaves to 10mm; flowers, male & female on separate plants, 4 white petals; fruit shiny red/orange
<i>Correa reflexa</i>	common correa	shrub, variable from prostrate to 3 m; leaves to 5 cm, reflexed with indented veins; flowers tubular, pendant, greenish.
<i>Craspedia glauca</i>	e common billybuttons	herb; tiny cream flowers in almost spherical heads;
<i>Dianella tasmanica</i>	forest flaxlily	perennial to 1.5m; leaves long, narrow, margins serrated; flowers on long stalks, 6-petalled, blue; fruit a blue/purple shiny berry
<i>Diplarrena moraea</i>	white flag-iris	strap-like leaves; white flowers

<i>Epacris impressa</i>	common heath	shrub; white, red or pink tubular flowers with dimples at base
<i>Epacris virgata</i>	pretty heath	erect woody bush to 2m, shiny rounded and pointed leaves, single white 5-petalled tubular flowers in the axils of top 2/3 of stems
<i>Eucalyptus globulus</i>	tasmanian bluegum	tree to 70m high, trunk rough at base, smooth, greyish/white above; leaves lance-shaped to 30cm long; fruit large, ribbed
<i>Eucalyptus pulchella</i>	white peppermint	Small tree to 20m, smooth white-grey bark, very narrow leaves 5-10cm, 5mm buds in clusters up to 18, nuts with valves level with rim
<i>Eucalyptus viminalis</i>	white gum	tree to 50 m, bark rough at base then smooth; leaves green; buds 3
<i>Exocarpos cupressiformis</i>	common native-cherry	tree; conifer-like foliage; edible orange coloured fruit
<i>Ficinia nodosa</i>	knobby clubsedge	densely tufted rush-like sedge to 90cm; flowers/fruit in compact grey/brown globular head
<i>Geranium potentilloides</i>	geranium	herb; lobed leaves; pink flowers; "storksbill" fruit
<i>Goodenia ovata</i>	hop native-primrose	shrub to 2m; leaves bright green, to 6cm, edges toothed; flowers yellow with petals in two groups
<i>Hibbertia riparia</i>	erect guineaflower	shrub; narrow leaves; golden 5-petalled flowers
<i>Hovea heterophylla</i>	winter purplepea	small shrub; dark green leaves; violet pea flowers
<i>Lagenophora stipitata</i>	blue bottledaisy	rosette herb; leaves hairy, to 8cm long; single flower head white or purplish on long hairy stem
<i>Leptospermum scoparium</i>	common teatree	shrub to 4m; leaves to 2cm with prickly pointed tips; flowers white; fruit with 5 slits, top convex, woody

<i>Linum marginale</i>	native flax	herb; slender stem to 50 cm tall; blue flowers 2 cm diam. on long stems
<i>Lomandra longifolia</i>	sagg	tussock of strap-like leaves with notched ends; flowers in spiny clusters
<i>Melaleuca pallida</i>	yellow bottlebrush	shrub/tree to 5 m; leaves blue/green; flowers yellow bottlebrush to 8 cm long.
<i>Microsorium pustulatum</i>	kangaroo fern	growing on trunks of other plants or rocks
<i>Monotoca glauca</i>	goldey wood	shrub to 3m; leaves to 10mm, sharp points; flowers white, 5 petalled, in small groups
<i>Notelaea ligustrina</i>	native olive	small tree; leaves lance-shaped to 5cm; small green to purple fruit
<i>Olearia viscosa</i>	viscid daisybush	shrub to 2m; leaves elliptical, 5-8cm long, sticky, dark green above, light green, hairy under; daisy flower heads with 4-6 white "petals" in crowded terminal clusters
<i>Pelargonium australe</i>	southern storksbill	herb growing in rock crevices; leaves kidney-shaped; flowers pink/white
<i>Pimelea nivea</i>	e bushmans bootlace	shrub to 2m; leaves round, dark green, shiny above, white & hairy below; flowers tubular, in spherical heads
<i>Poa labillardierei</i>	tussock grass	Large, coarse, densely tufted perennial; flower stems rounded, erect, flowers cream or brown above the leaves
<i>Pomaderris apetala</i>	common dogwood	shrub/tree to 10 m; leaves to 10 cm with deep veins, white under; flowers cream/green in branched clusters.
<i>Pterostylis nana</i>	dwarf greenhood	orchid to 15cm high; leaves to 15mm long, in rosette; flower solitary, green with thread-like "ears"
<i>Pultenaea juniperina</i>	prickly beauty	shrub to 2.5m; leaves to 12mm, sharp pointed; goledn pea flowers at ends of branches
<i>Spyridium obovatum</i>	smooth dustymiller	shrub/tree 1-15 m; leaves obovate to 2 cm; flowers small in compact heads with single floral leaf.
<i>Styphelia humifusa</i>	native cranberry	ground cover; prickly leaves; red tube flowers in winter
<i>Themeda triandra</i>	kangaroo grass	Tufted perennial grass, up to 120cm
<i>Veronica formosa</i>	common speedwell bush	shrub to 2 m; leaves crowded, green, to 1.5 cm long; flowers 4 petals usually pale blue/mauve, clustered.
<i>Viola hederacea</i>	ivyleaf violet	herb; perennial, spreading; kidney shaped leaves; violet flowers on stalks
<i>Zieria arborescens</i>	stinkwood	shrub/tree to 8 m; leaves with 3 leaflets to 10 cm with unpleasant smell when crushed; flowers with 4 white/pink petals.

GJ [*Acacia dealbata*](#)

silver wattle
tree with grey green feathery leaves; golden flowers



GJ [*Acacia genistifolia*](#)

spreading wattle
shrub; golden flowers in spheres; stiff dagger-like leaves



RW [*Acacia mearnsii*](#)

black wattle
tree with green feathery leaves; pale golden flowers



GJ [Acacia melanoxylon](#)

blackwood
tree to 30m; leaves with parallel veins; round flower heads



RW [Acacia mucronata](#)

subsp. longifolia
caterpillar wattle
erect shrub/small tree; leaves narrow linear to 15cm long with short narrow point; yellow flowers in spikes



GJ [Acacia stricta](#)

hop wattle
shrub with ridged stems; leaves grey-green, to 10cm long; paired balls of pale yellow flowers in leaf axils



GJ [Acacia verticillata](#)

prickly moses
shrub 50cm to 6m high; leaves in whorls, narrow pungent pointed, to 2cm long; flowers in cylindrical yellow spikes



GJ [Adiantum aethiopicum](#)

common maidenhair
delicate plant with fan-shaped leaves

black sheoak
tree; fruit like small pine cones; segmented needle-like
"leaves"



GJ [*Allocasuarina verticillata*](#)

drooping sheoak
tree with "leaves" hanging down or drooping



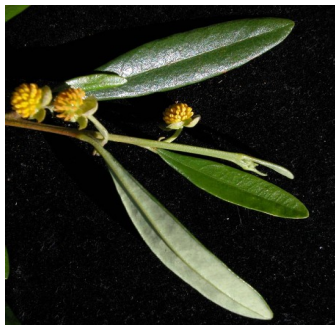
GJ [*Asplenium flabellifolium*](#)

necklace fern
small fern with leaves pinnately divided into wedge-shaped
leaflets, alternately arranged



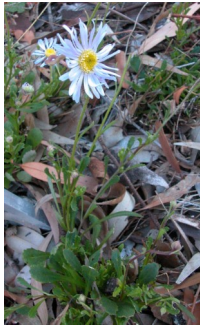
GJ [*Bedfordia salicina*](#)

tasmanian blanketleaf
shrub/tree to 5m; leaves dark green above silver hairy below;
yellow daisy flowers in groups



GJ [*Beyeria viscosa*](#)

pinkwood
small tree; inconspicuous flower; female plants have 3-lobed
fruit



AS *Brachyscome spathulata*

spoonleaf daisy

herb perennial, to 30cm high; leaves spoon-shaped, to 6cm long; flower head usually mauve, to 4cm diam, on long stalk



GJ *Brunonia australis*

blue pincushion

rosette herb; grey/green leaves; cornflower blue flower heads



GJ *Bulbine semibarbata*

leek lilly

Tufted herb to 30 cm; roots fibrous; leaves flattish, spreading or erect, 5–2 cm long, 1–5 mm wide; flowers yellow, 6 petalled, on erect scape.



GJ *Bursaria spinosa*

prickly box

small tree; distinctive "purses" (seed cases); white starry flowers



JC *Caladenia carnea*

pink fingers

herb to 25 cm; single narrow narrow; 1 to 6 showy pink flowers



GJ [Callitris rhomboidea](#)

oyster bay pine

Narrow tree to 6m, green leaves to 2-5mm in whorls of 3, pear shaped female cones 2cm, with 6 pointed scales of similar size



GJ [Cassytha glabella](#)

slender dodderlaurel

slender parasitic twiner; appears leafless; tiny white flowers in bunches on short stalks



GJ [Clematis aristata](#)

mountain clematis

climber; leaves multi-lobed; large white star-like flowers



GJ [Coprosma quadrifida](#)

native currant

erect shrub to 4m; leaves to 10mm; flowers, male & female on separate plants, 4 white petals; fruit shiny red/orange



GJ [Correa reflexa](#)

var. reflexa

common correa

shrub, variable from prostrate to 3 m; leaves to 5 cm, reflexed with indented veins; flowers tubular, pendant, greenish.



GJ [*Craspedia glauca*](#)

common billybuttons
herb; tiny cream flowers in almost spherical heads;



BC [*Dianella tasmanica*](#)

forest flaxlily
perennial to 1.5m; leaves long, narrow, margins serrated;
flowers on long stalks, 6-petalled, blue; fruit a blue/purple shiny
berry



GJ [*Diplarrena moraea*](#)

white flag-iris
strap-like leaves; white flowers



AS [*Dodonaea viscosa*](#)
subsp. *spathulata*



GJ [*Epacris impressa*](#)

common heath
shrub; white, red or pink tubular flowers with dimples at base



GJ [Epacris virgata](#)

pretty heath

erect woody bush to 2m, shiny rounded and pointed leaves, single white 5-petalled tubular flowers in the axils of top 2/3 of stems



GJ [Eucalyptus globulus](#)

tasmanian bluegum

tree to 70m high, trunk rough at base, smooth, greyish/white above; leaves lance-shaped to 30cm long; fruit large, ribbed



GJ [Eucalyptus pulchella](#)

white peppermint

Small tree to 20m, smooth white-grey bark, very narrow leaves 5-10cm, 5mm buds in clusters up to 18, nuts with valves level with rim



GJ [Eucalyptus viminalis](#)

white gum

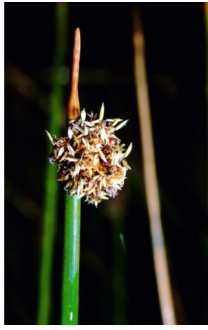
tree to 50 m, bark rough at base then smooth; leaves green; buds 3



GJ [Exocarpos cupressiformis](#)

common native-cherry

tree; conifer-like foliage; edible orange coloured fruit



GJ *Ficinia nodosa*

knobby clubsedge
densely tufted rush-like sedge to 90cm; flowers/fruit in compact grey/brown globular head



RW *Geranium potentilloides*

geranium
herb; lobed leaves; pink flowers; "storksbill" fruit



GJ *Goodenia ovata*

hop native-primrose
shrub to 2m; leaves bright green, to 6cm, edges toothed;
flowers yellow with petals in two groups



BC *Hibbertia riparia*

erect guineaflower
shrub; narrow leaves; golden 5-petalled flowers



GJ *Hovea heterophylla*

winter purplepea
small shrub; dark green leaves; violet pea flowers



RS [Lagenophora stipitata](#)

blue bottledaisy
rosette herb; leaves hairy, to 8cm long; single flower head
white or purplish on long hairy stem



GJ [Leptospermum scoparium](#)

common teatree
shrub to 4m; leaves to 2cm with prickly pointed tips; flowers
white; fruit with 5 slits, top convex, woody



GJ [Linum marginale](#)

native flax
herb; slender stem to 50 cm tall; blue flowers 2 cm diam. on
long stems



GJ [Lomandra longifolia](#)

sagg
tussock of strap-like leaves with notched ends; flowers in spiny
clusters



GJ [Melaleuca pallida](#)

yellow bottlebrush
shrub/tree to 5 m; leaves blue/green; flowers yellow
bottlebrush to 8 cm long.



GJ [Microsorium pustulatum](#)

kangaroo fern
growing on trunks of other plants or rocks



RW [Monotoca glauca](#)

goldey wood
shrub to 3m; leaves to 10mm, sharp points; flowers white, 5
petalled, in small groups



GJ [Notelaea ligustrina](#)

native olive
small tree; leaves lance-shaped to 5cm; small green to purple
fruit



GJ [Olearia viscosa](#)

viscid daisybush
shrub to 2m; leaves elliptical, 5-8cm long, sticky, dark green
above, light green, hairy under; daisy flower heads with 4-6
white "petals" in crowded terminal clusters



GJ [Pelargonium australe](#)

southern storksbill
herb growing in rock crevices; leaves kidney-shaped; flowers
pink/white



RW *Pimelea nivea*

bushmans bootlace
shrub to 2m; leaves round, dark green, shiny above, white & hairy below; flowers tubular, in spherical heads

Poa labillardierei

tussock grass
Large, coarse, densely tufted perennial; flower stems rounded, erect, flowers cream or brown above the leaves



GJ *Pomaderris apetala*

common dogwood
shrub/tree to 10 m; leaves to 10 cm with deep veins, white under; flowers cream/green in branched clusters.



JC *Pterostylis nana*

dwarf greenhood
orchid to 15cm high; leaves to 15mm long, in rosette; flower solitary, green with thread-like "ears"



RW *Pultenaea juniperina*

prickly beauty
shrub to 2.5m; leaves to 12mm, sharp pointed; golden pea flowers at ends of branches



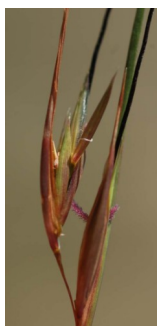
GJ [*Spyridium obovatum*](#)

smooth dustymiller
shrub/tree 1-15 m; leaves obovate to 2 cm; flowers small in compact heads with single floral leaf.



GJ [*Styphelia humifusa*](#)

native cranberry
ground cover; prickly leaves; red tube flowers in winter



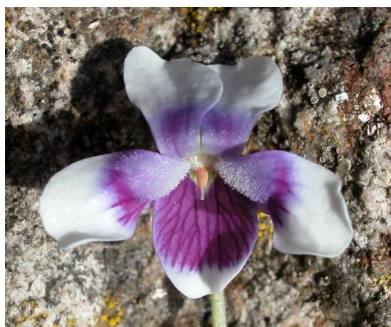
GJ [*Themeda triandra*](#)

kangaroo grass
Tufted perennial grass, up to 120cm



AS [*Veronica formosa*](#)

common speedwell bush
shrub to 2 m; leaves crowded, green, to 1.5 cm long; flowers 4 petals usually pale blue/mauve, clustered.



GJ [*Viola hederacea*](#)

ivyleaf violet
herb; perennial, spreading; kidney shaped leaves; violet flowers on stalks



GJ [Zieria arborescens](#)

stinkwood

shrub/tree to 8 m; leaves with 3 leaflets to 10 cm with unpleasant smell when crushed; flowers with 4 white/pink petals.
